**NOTIFICATION OF ESSENTIAL MAINTENANCE WORKS**  
**A45 Eastbound and Westbound - M1 Junction 15 to Queen Eleanor Interchange**

I am writing to let you know that we will be carrying out essential maintenance works on the A45 between M1 Junction 15 and Queen Eleanor Interchange, works will be carried out in both directions including exit and entry slips at Grange Park and East Hunsbury.

During our scheme of work, we will:

- Replace damaged drains, kerbs and footpaths where required.
- Refresh road markings and install road studs.
- Carry out vegetation and overburden clearance from footpaths.
- Resurfacing of carriageway including slip roads.

Once completed, all road users will benefit from improved road safety and will provide relief to the existing highways system.

**When will the work take place?**

Work is due to start **8<sup>th</sup> January 2024** and is scheduled for completion by the **end of March 2024**

Please note that all our planned roadworks may be subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

**How will the work affect traffic?**

To keep our programme for these works as short as possible and to minimise disruption to the local community, residents, businesses, and road users we'll work **Monday to Friday, 8pm** until **6am**, some weekend closures will be required these will be confirmed in due course.

The works will be carried out under a full carriageway closure which includes slip roads.

During all road closures we will put in place fully signed diversion routes which have been agreed with Local Authorities for this important safety improvement work. All carriageways will be open as usual outside our working hours.

No HGV's will be granted access during restricted times, HGV's will need to follow the diversion in place.

### **How will the work affect businesses and residents?**

We'll make sure that access to businesses and residences is maintained wherever possible.

We apologise for any inconvenience caused and will do our very best to complete this essential maintenance work as quickly as possible, keeping disturbances and noise to a minimum.
